APOSTLES' CREED (Said By All)

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth:

And in Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, Born of the Virgin Mary, Suffered under Pontius Pilate, Was crucified, dead, and buried. He descended into hell; The third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, And sits on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; From there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit; The holy Catholic Church; The Communion of Saints; The Forgiveness of sins; The Resurrection of the body; And the Life everlasting. Amen.

Sermon

(After the Apostles' Creed, the Minister may deliver a short sermon.)

THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

Minister:

Our fellow Christians of other branches of Christ's Church, who have been Baptized in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, are affectionately invited to the Lord's Table.

THE CONFESSION

Minister:

You who do truly and earnestly repent of your sins, and are in love and charity with your neighbours, and intend to lead a new life, following the commandments of God, and walking from henceforth in His holy ways; Draw near with faith, and take this holy Sacrament to your comfort; and make your humble confession to Almighty God, devoutly saying.

ALL:

O Almighty Father, Lord of heaven and earth, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed. Have mercy upon us, O God, after your great goodness; according to the multitude of your mercies, do away with our offences and cleanse us from our sins; for Jesus Christ's sake. *Amen.*

THE ABSOLUTION

Minister:

The Almighty and merciful Lord grant you Absolution and Remission of all your sins, true repentance, amendment of life, and the grace and consolation of His Holy Spirit. *Amen.*

SURSUM CORDA

Minister: The Lord be with you

People: And with your spirit.

Minister: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up unto the Lord.

Priest: Let us give thanks unto the Lord, our God.

People: It is good and right so to do.

Minister: It is very good, right, and our required duty, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks unto You, O Lord, Holy Father, Almighty, Everlasting God.

Therefore with Angels and Archangels, and with all the company of heaven, we praise and magnify Your glorious Name; evermore praising You, and saying (singing),

THE SANCTUS

ALL:

HOLY, HOLY, HOLY, Lord God of hosts, heaven and earth are full of Your glory: Glory be to You, O Lord Most High. Blessed is He Who comes in the Name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Minister:

All glory be to You, Almighty God, our heavenly Father, Who of Your tender mercy did give Your only Son Jesus Christ to suffer death upon the Cross for our redemption; Who made there (by His one oblation of Himself once offered) a full, perfect, and sufficient sacrifice, offering, and complete payment, for the sins of the whole world; and did institute, and in His Holy Gospel command us to continue, a perpetual memory of that His precious death and sacrifice until His coming again;

For in the night in which He was betrayed, He took Bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying, "Take, eat, this is My Body which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of Me." Likewise, after supper, He took the Cup; and, when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink this, all of you; for this is My Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you and for many, for the remission of sins: Do this, as often as you shall drink it, in remembrance of Me. **Amen.**

THE INVOCATION

Minister:

And we most humbly ask You, O merciful Father, to hear us; and of Your almighty goodness, grant to bless and sanctify with your Word and Holy Spirit, these Your gifts and creatures of bread and wine; that we receiving them according to Your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ's holy institution, in remembrance of His death and passion, may be partakers of His most blessed Body and Blood.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Minister: And now, as our Saviour Christ has taught us, we are bold to say,

ALL: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever and ever. Amen.

THE COMMUNION

Minister:

The Body of our Lord Jesus Christ, which was given for you, preserve your body and soul unto everlasting life. Take and eat this in remembrance that Christ died for you, and feed on Him in your heart by faith with thanksgiving. ***Amen.***

The Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, which was shed for you, preserve your body and soul unto everlasting life. Drink this in remembrance that Christ's Blood was shed for you, and be thankful. ***Amen.***

BENEDICTION

Minister: The peace of God, which passes all understanding, keep your hearts and minds in the knowledge and love of God, and of His Son Jesus Christ our Lord: And the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be among you and remain with you always. ***Amen.***

THE DISMISSAL

Minister: Go forth now to love and serve the Lord and each other.

People: Thanks be to God!

Minister: The grace of the Lord be with you all.

People: And also with you!
